

Reviewable Decisions

The Local Government Act 2019 (the Act) requires a council to make a list setting out each category of reviewable decisions publicly available.

Section 322 of the Act defines a reviewable decision as a decision that is designated reviewable either by the Act (or a by-law under the Act), or by resolution of the council.

The Act designated the following decisions of a council as reviewable:

- (a) a decision in relation to the correction of an entry in the assessment record under section 232(1) or 233(7);
- (b) a regulatory order under section 286;
- (c) a decision to refuse to suppress a person's details in publicly available material under section 293(5).

Alice Springs Town Council has made no decisions designated as reviewable by resolution of Council.
