Role Description

Located at the Alice Springs Aquatic & Leisure Centre (ASALC), this volunteer position will support the maintenance of a safe garden environment around the Aquatic Centre.

Key Responsibilities

- Maintain ASALC grounds including garden and lawn areas.
- Report maintenance issues.
- Ensure that the grounds are kept clean and tidy.
- · Carry out safe use of pesticides if required.
- Perform regular checks on reticulation / irrigation system.
- Maintain gardening equipment and supplies, including fuel checks and battery charging.
- Pressure clean paths / entrance way.

Selection Criteria

- 1. Ability to work in a cross-cultural environment.
- 2. Excellent interpersonal skills with the ability to effectively engage a diverse range of community members.
- 3. Current "Working with Children" clearance (Ochre Card).
- 4. National Police Certificate.

Training and Induction

Orientation to the Aquatic and Leisure Centre and subsequent specific orientation to the role will be provided.
