Australian Disability Parking Permit/s for an Organisation – Conditions of Use



1. The following regulatory authorities apply to this application:

2. All employees of the organisation who will be making use of a permit must read and understand the conditions of use of the permit.

3. The organisation must keep a register of each permit as we do request permit numbers for renewals and reprints.

4. Displaying the permit:

- Permits must only be used when the vehicle is being used to transport an eligible individual.
- > The permit only needs to be displayed when parking under the above conditions.
- The permit must be displayed inside the windscreen or hung from the rear-view mirror.
- > The permit number and expiry date must be visible from the exterior of the vehicle.
- If the permit is hung off the rear-view mirror then it must be removed before the vehicle is in motion to avoid obstructing the view of the driver.

5. The permit:

- Is valid if the vehicle is being used to transport an eligible individual.
- Allows the vehicle to be parked in parking spaces that are signposted and have the people with disabilities symbol painted on the road surface.
- > Do not exceed any parking sign time limits applying to a parking area for people with disabilities.

6. Concessions:

- If there are no parking bays for a person with a disability the following concessions will be made on other *parking bays:*
 - Twice the period indicated on signage.
 - ❖ E.G. 15 minutes extends to 30 minutes, 1 hour extends to 2 hours, 2 hours extend to 4 hours
- After the concessions time permit is over normal parking restrictions apply.
- Please note: If the parking sign is in an area set aside for people with disabilities, the additional parking concessions do not apply.

7. Caution:

- If the Organisation allows misuse of the disability permit allocated to them to take place, this can lead to the permit being revoked and the Council may pursue enforcement action.
- If it has been found that the **Organisation** has provided false and misleading information or details, this can lead to the application being rejected and the Council may pursue enforcement action.
- ➤ If it has been found after the issue of the permit that the **Organisation** has provided false and misleading information or details, this can lead to the permit being revoked and the Council may pursue enforcement action.
