



Recycling Cardboard & Paper

You can recycle cardboard and paper at the Regional Waste Management Facility for FREE. But there are a few things to consider.

Separate your materials

To recycle successfully paper, cardboard, glossy paper and newspaper each need to be separated in the provided skip bins.

If they are not separated they are considered contaminated.

Contamination

- All materials must be kept clean and separated
- No plastic or metal material
- Shredded paper must be emptied out of plastics bags
- Food-soiled cardboard (such as pizza boxes) cannot be recycled

How is it recycled?

All materials are baled through a machine into 500kg cubes. The cubes are sent interstate to a recycling facility where it is recycled back into paper products such as cardboard boxes.
