Plastic Bags – what's the difference...?





Plastic, biodegradable or degradable plastic bags all contain some form of plastic.

Plastic doesn't decompose – it just breaks down into micro-plastics and is very hard to remove (especially from contaminated compost!).



Look for the compostable symbol! Compostable bags are the best for the environment as they are made from sugarcane, a natural material that breaks down completely.

A plain (uncoated) paper bag will break down, too! Or even better, bring your own reusable shopping bags!
