### Regional Waste Management Facility

All of the following items can be recycled at Council's Regional Waste Management Facility:

- Cardboard
- Glass bottles
- Green waste
- Aluminium & steel cans
- Household & car batteries
- E-waste
- Paint

Items dropped-off must be separated, as much as possible, into the separate cages at the RWMF's Transfer Station in order to be recycled.

### Rediscovery Centre

- Household items & furniture

## What can't be recycled in Alice Springs?

Plastics that are not already covered by the Container Deposit Scheme cannot be recycled at this stage.

Such plastics include unflavoured (regular) milk bottles, yoghurt and margarine cartons, cordial bottles and other household plastics.

### Chemical Disposal Centre
