Primary Objective

Work as part of a construction and maintenance team, undertaking street sweeping and a range of general maintenance activities

Key Responsibilities

- Sweep roads, streets, parking areas and car parks safely using a street sweeper

- Remove heavy concrete and steel lids and clean out of side entry pits
- Assist with the cleaning up of spills e.g. oils, fuel, concrete
- Undertake general cleaning, labouring and maintenance
- Undertake quality general maintenance and minor repairs on the street sweeper
- Identify and report necessary part replacements and major faults
- Train employees in street sweeper operations as required
- Carry out a range of appropriate support duties as directed by the Supervisor
- Work a reasonable amount of overtime as required

- 4. Ability to work unsupervised following instructions and procedures, including keeping accurate work records and reporting issues to Supervisor

- 6. Ability to co-operate with the general public and work as part of an effective team
- 7. Ability to assist in training of other employees in street sweeper
- 8. Current HR Class Drivers Licence to be able to drive in the NT
