John Boyle questioned if sports with limited numbers and therefore pay significantly less participation fees than the more popular sports are less likely to receive SFAC funds/assistance.

Bruce Walker advised that the levies which sporting clubs pay into the SFAC Trust have no effect on the outcome of works requested.

#### 4. BUSINESS ARISING FROM MINUTES

#### 4.1 Works Program

Works program tabled

Facilities Maintenance Officer advised that he has been unable to obtain new quotes as contractors are reluctant to give quotes unless they know they are going to get the work.

**ACTION:** Director Technical Service and Council staff to update works program to show in house estimates on high priority items, and add extra columns for OH & S, High Priority and Capital. Updated program tabled at next SFAC meeting.

#### 4.2 Sports Master Plan Review

Bruce Walker commented that the Sports Master Plan does not address the maintenance of ageing structures and facilities and suggested that the SFAC members read the document from 2010 and provide feedback so that a deputation to Council can be prepared. Many of the recommendations from the SFAC Deputation (2005) were implemented.

ACTION: Bruce Walker to circulate Review of Master Plan

ACTION: SFAC members to provide feedback to Sport and Recreation Officer within two weeks

Bruce Walker questioned if it was wise to upgrade the building if it still does not serve the sports that use the facility.

Mike Bonjiorno advised that he would like to arrange a FAT meeting with the sports involved at Jim McConville to discuss the facility and the way it is utilised.

**ACTION:** Mike Bonjiorno to arrange FAT meeting regarding Jim McConville and provide detailed scope of works to SFAC next meeting.
