 - (a) diseased;
 - (b) injured;
 - (c) savage;
 - (d) destructive; or
 - (e) stray.

(2)	To avoid doubt, an authorised person may enter upon any
	land in exercise of the power under clause (1).

(a) that the animal has attacked or injured a person or animal; or

- (4) The animal must not be released unless the applicable maintenance and release fees are paid together with:
 - (a) any fees or costs payable under By-law 138; and
 - (b) any outstanding penalties for which the owner of the animal is liable under these By-laws or any other By-laws applying to the municipality.
